Job Description for KIDS MINISTER

Purpose

The Kids Minister at Jersey Church plays a vital role in leading children from *Birth through 5th grade* to know and follow Jesus in age-appropriate and engaging ways. This position is responsible for creating a fun, welcoming, and spiritually rich environment where kids can grow in their faith and understanding of who God is. A key emphasis is partnering with parents in the spiritual development of their children and helping every child feel seen, known, and loved.

The Kids Minister will oversee all aspects of Jersey Kids Ministry, including Sunday programming, events, and outreach. They will personally lead in Children's Church and/or build and empower a volunteer team to do so. A significant part of this role includes discipling children—helping them learn how to share their faith, engage in prayer, and interact with God's Word in ways they can understand and apply.

This role also includes recruiting, training, and developing volunteers, as well as building strong relationships with families to support their faith journey both at home and at church.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop and lead a well-rounded Kids Ministry (birth–5th grade) that aligns with Jersey Church's Vision, Mission, and Strategy.
- Oversee both the Elementary and Preschool Ministry teams, ensuring consistent execution of church-wide goals and values.
- Create a fun, safe, spiritually rich environment where children can grow in their faith and learn about Jesus in age-appropriate ways.
- Participate in and lead team meetings related to Worship Kids Style, Grow Groups, Journey, VBS, and other ministry environments.
- Collaborate with the Next Generation Ministry Team on church-wide initiatives and special projects.
- Continually assess facility and space needs to support the growth and effectiveness of the Kids Ministry.
- Disciple children by teaching them how to share their faith, pray, and engage with God's Word in personal and meaningful ways.
- Develop and implement evangelistic programs designed to introduce children to Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior.
- Provide resources and training opportunities to equip parents as the primary spiritual leaders of their children.
- Follow up with children who make spiritual decisions, offering guidance and encouragement toward continued growth.
- Conduct home visits with families as needed to build relationships and offer pastoral care.
- Recruit, train, equip, and shepherd a growing team of volunteers for Sunday mornings, midweek programs, and special events.
