EXPERIENCE

Dale completed his seminary work at Louisiana Baptist Theological Seminary and was ordained for Gospel ministry at Orlando Baptist Church in 1997, where he served as Associate Pastor for 12 years. He subsequently served as Senior Pastor at Avalon Church in East Orlando for 15 years.

In 2019, he was responsible for and became Pastor of a “church plant” in Bithlo, Florida (near Orlando). This church exists to minister to underserved and poverty-stricken families, and give them a place in which to learn about God’s love, to worship and to serve their community. Additionally, he has volunteered at a small private school within the church community as a guidance counselor, dean, chaplain, and teacher, as well as helping with the transportation needs of the students and their families.
