Our Identity in Christ.

1. In Christ, you are loved as an adopted child of God.

4 Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. 5 God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure. **Ephesians 1:4-5** (NLT)

2. In Christ, you have been forgiven; that is, you are a saint redeemed by God.

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace. **Ephesians 1:7**

25 God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith.... 26 he did it to demonstrate his righteousness at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

Romans 3:25a-26

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

"Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life. **John 5:24**
