Duruflé (1902-1986) was a French organist and composer who became Louis Vierne's assistant at Notre-Dame in 1927). He was married to Jeanne Marie-Madeleine Duruflé, a virtuoso organist, and they were a well-known organ duo. He was highly critical of his work, and did not write a large output, but his organ works are much loved and frequently played. His Requiem is frequently performed, and is widely regarded as one of the most beautiful written for organ (also small orchestra) and choir.
