The motet is by Irish composer Matthew Owens (b. 1971), Director of Music at Belfast Cathedral where he leads the professional, all adult choir of Northern Ireland's national cathedral. During communion the quartet sings the Coventry Carol, which dates from the 15th century, here arranged by Martin Shaw.
