In the summer of 1908, George Gough Booth and Ellen Scripps Booth-two of metro Detroit's most influential yet often overlooked philanthropists-moved into their newly built Cranbrook House, the first year-round estate of its kind in Bloomfield Hills. Designed in the English Tudor, Arts & Crafts style by noted Detroit architect Albert Kahn, the home served as the Booths' residence for 40 years and became the heart of what would grow into the Cranbrook Educational Community.

The cost of our exclusive tour and lunch is \$70 per person. Reservations must be

received at the Kirk by Tuesday, December 9, and are limited to 50 attendees, so this deadline is important. Please arrive no later than 10:30am. Also note, the tour is NOT handicap accessible.
