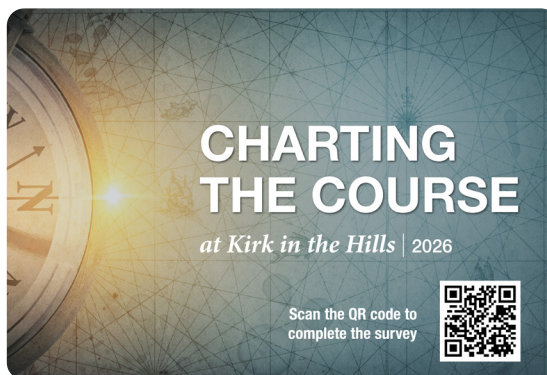

## Listening for God in the Silence as we Chart Our Way Forward



As we prepare for worship this Sunday at Kirk in the Hills, our mountaintop journey through Scripture continues with one of its most tender stories—Elijah's encounter with God on Mount Horeb. In 1 Kings 19, Elijah arrives exhausted and discouraged, expecting God to appear in dramatic power, only to discover

God in "a sound of sheer silence." The mountain becomes not a place of spectacle, but of restoration, where God meets Elijah with quiet, sustaining presence.

This story speaks to anyone who feels worn down by the demands of life or faith. It reminds us that not every encounter with God is loud or dramatic. Some are gentle, slow, and deeply healing. In a noisy and hurried world, worship offers space to breathe, listen, and be renewed.

That same posture of attentive listening shapes our life together as a congregation. As the Kirk continues Charting the Course, we invite you to participate in the brief, confidential congregational survey if you have not yet done so. Each reflection helps us listen more faithfully to where the Spirit may be leading us next.

As we prepare for Sunday—and for the coming season of Lent, which begins soon—may we practice the holy work of slowing down, listening, and making room for God's transforming presence.
