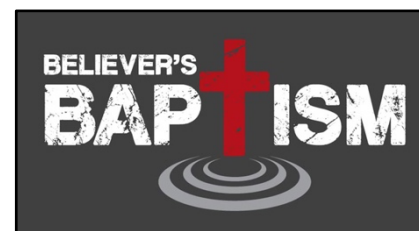
July 26, Aug. 2
