- Icebreaker -

- 1. Peace. A single word that means so many things to people all around the world but can only be found in one person. What has your search for peace looked like over the years?
- **2.** Read <u>Colossians 1:15-16</u> and <u>Philippians 2:6-7</u>. How does Jesus' divine identity and his decision to be born as a baby, live with us, and go to the cross for us help you understand the relevance of Christmas?
- **3.** Read <u>1 John 4:9-10</u> and consider Pastor Tom's statement: "We are the reason for the season!" If we (lost and found people) are the whole point of Christmas, how does that change the way we talk about and celebrate the holiday?
- **4.** To have peace close at hand and not experience it, how tragic! God's gift of eternal life through faith in Jesus alone is available to all but must be accepted and opened to be experienced. (**Romans 5:10-11**) How has your experience with this gift shaped your life? Take some time to share your story with your group.
- **5.** If you haven't yet accepted this gift, what's holding you back from accepting it now? Ask your questions, wrestle with the decision honestly and then unwrap the greatest gift to ever be offered! (See how to do this in the message notes under: "How can I find Christmas Peace?"

1. Relevant

Jesus didn't start as a baby in a manger.

He is the Creator God (note Colossians 1:15-16).

...He chose to come into our world the same way we all do...by being <u>born</u> into it.

Jesus was in every <u>sense</u> a human being (note **Philippians 2:6-7**).

Because Jesus came to earth and experienced what it means to be <u>human</u>, He understands you and me.

Christmas is not the celebration for billions of people worldwide of some average, normal baby.

2. The Reason

...<u>nature</u> cannot teach us that God is loving, forgiving, and has a plan and purpose for life.

Only $\underline{\text{Jesus}}$ can teach us those things.

Being personally <u>connected</u> to our Creator is how we're going to experience and live that full life.
