- Icebreaker -

What is your favorite Christmas movie and why?

1. Pastor Tom said that one of the reasons for Jesus coming to this earth was to help us “delete our misconceptions about God” (See **John 1:18**). What are some common misconceptions about God you have heard or may even still believe?
2. Jesus said in **John 14:9**, “Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father.” Take a few moments to discuss the significance of Jesus’ statement as a group. How does this truth challenge and/or expand your view of God, the Father?
3. Read **Luke 2:32**. Pastor Tom said that light “...helps us see things as they really are.” What has the light of Jesus helped you to see from God’s perspective and what other things are only now being slowly illuminated?
4. Pastor Tom called Christmas “...a personal invitation from God Himself to us that God delivered in person.” Read **John 3:16** and **1 John 4:9-10**. What does this invitation tell you about God’s disposition toward this world, including you?
5. The result of saying “YES!” to God’s invitation is a loving, living relationship with Him (See **Romans 5:11**). It’s clear, as Pastor Tom said, that “Not only does God want you in His family...He wants you to be His friend.” If you have never said “YES!” to God’s invitation to this friendship, what more are you waiting for; what is keeping you from saying “YES!” today?
