

So what's the relevance of Christmas?

God Came to Earth

Jesus didn't <u>start</u> as a baby in a manger (note **Philippians 2:6**; **Colossians 1:15-16**).

Seeing Jesus is seeing God (note John 1:14).

God Became a Man (note Philippians 2:7)

- A. Jesus was <u>born</u> like us (note **Luke 2:5-7**) ...the whole history of the world rested in that one fragile infant.
- B. Jesus grew like us (note Luke 2:52).
- C. He was <u>tempted</u> like us (note **Hebrews 4:14-16**) Jesus can relate to us when we <u>struggle</u> with temptations.
- D. He <u>suffered</u> like us Jesus felt pain, disappointment, <u>fatigue</u>, and knew loneliness (note **Matthew 26:38**). He became what we are so we can become like <u>He</u> is.

Jesus Was Born to Die (note Philippians 2:8)

- A. To demonstrate God's <u>love</u> (note **Romans 5:8**; **John 15:13**) If you want to know how much God loves you, look at the cross.
- B. To pay for our sins Jesus pain our <u>penalty</u>. He took our <u>place</u> (note **Romans 3:23**; **1 Peter 2:24**). Jesus came to be the Savior of the world (note **Luke 2:11**). If we didn't need a Savior, God wouldn't have <u>wasted</u> the effort to send one. A personal relationship with God through Jesus means <u>freedom</u> from guilt, worry, fear, and purposelessness in life.

Jesus is Lord (note Philippians 2:9-11; Luke 2:11)

- A. I acknowledge Jesus is really <u>God</u> He's the Lord over my life, my <u>Leader</u>, and that means I'll do what He tells me to do.
- B. I believe Jesus is in <u>control</u> no matter what the circumstances are and how <u>bleak</u> things may seem, Jesus is Lord.
- C. I commit <u>all</u> of my life to Jesus I seek to live according to His <u>plans</u> and purposes (note **Romans 10:9**).
