What is the most beautiful human-made thing you have ever personally seen or heard?

- **1.** Read **Philippians 3:20**. How does your current status as a citizen of heaven impact your life right now?
- **2.** Pastor Tom said that we are "To live near, but not in...to be close, but not from...to be in, but not of." What are you doing to walk that line, and how do you know when you've crossed over it?
- **3.** Read **Philippians 3:17-19**. Verse 19 describes the values of the culture we live in. Which of those values are most tempting to you and what are you doing to keep from drifting into it?
- **4.** Pastor Tom said that "genuine citizen[s] of heaven" will think and live differently from the culture (Romans 12:2; Colossians 3:1-2; 1 Peter 2:11). Assuming Paul was not instructing the Colossians to obsess over *pearly gates* or *streets of gold*, how would thinking about "things of heaven, not things of earth" change the way you live?
- **5.** "Don't worry if you're different from the world...," Pastor Tom said, "...worry if you're not." What did he mean by this and how is it reflected in your life?



Our value isn't determined by the culture (note Colossians 3:1-2).

But when I say 'YES!' to Jesus as Lord, God works throughout my whole life to <u>transform</u> my mind.
