**The Instruction: Reclaim Normal through honor. (Romans 12:9-16)**

- Not quick flattery, but guided goodness. (v.9)
- Not a trade-off, but committed out-doing. (v.10)
- Not reluctant, but passionate. (v.11)
- Not comfortable, but inconvenienced. (v.12)
- Not selective, but unfiltered. (v.13)
- Not reactive, but gracious. (v.14)
- Not unresponsive, but empathetic. (v. 15)
- Not competitive, but humble. (v.16)

**The Proof: Honor in every direction.**
