- Run volunteer trainings, participate in development, encouragement, appreciation, and casting vision to volunteer teams
- Adopt the "rhythm" and curriculum model of Riverside Kids
- Utilize check-in system and all database functions
- Operate under a quality improvement model which constantly evaluates facility, activities and more
- Participate in the budgeting process
- Represent RK on stage in Worship Center for special Sundays (e.g. Child Dedication, 1st Grade Bible Presentation, No Limits Graduation)
- Lead No Limits class at campus if numbers warrant it, or be a part of teaching at the Central Campus.
- Organize/oversee Kids special events at campus
- Help build a worship crew team of kids serving on Sunday mornings



- Be a key participant in larger all-campus Kids events like summer and winter camps, helping teach, recruiting leaders to attend, etc.
- Facilitate and recruit Kids volunteers for special services like Christmas Production, Christmas Eve services and Easter services
- Oversee organization of classrooms, materials, cleaning of toys, maintenance of equipment, stock of supply closet, etc.
- Set up, run, and oversee stock for campus K-Kash Store
- Support and participate with your campus team, including special events specific to the campus
- Participate in monthly RK team meetings
- Engage with the larger staff team of Riverside Church, including all campuses
