



REV. DR. WILLIE ELDER

Rev. Dr. Willie Elder is a native of Lawrenceville, Virginia home of the world famous "Brunswick Stew." He is the second of two children born to Willie and Helen Towns-Elder.

Pastor Elder was licensed to preach December 3, 2000 and ordained May 2009, both at Mount Pleasant Baptist Church (MPBC) in



Alexandria, VA. On September 21, 2019, he was privileged to be installed as the 10th Pastor of Bethel Baptist Church (Madison Mills) in Orange, VA.

Before accepting the pastorate at Bethel, Dr. Elder served faithfully for nine years at Christian Way Baptist Church in Falls Church, VA. Five of those years as Assistant-Pastor. For several years prior to that, he served the MPBC in several capacities: Prison Ministry Director, Adult Church School Teacher, Men's Ministry President, Deacon Vice-Chair, and Usher.

He is a former President of the Baptist Ministers Conference of Northern Virginia and Vicinity (2014-2016) and currently serves as the 2nd Vice-Moderator of the Wayland Blue Ridge Baptist Association, Inc.

Dr. Elder attended the University of Maryland where he received a *Bachelor of Science Degree* in Business Management. He is also a graduate of Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union University, Richmond, VA earning a *Master of Divinity Degree*. He attended the Virginia University of Lynchburg Leonard N. Smith School of Religion where he obtained his *Doctor of Ministry Degree*. His dissertation project was titled: *Restructuring the Ministry of a Small Rural Church: Posturing for a Post-Pandemic Environment*.

Pastor Elder is a 20-year veteran of the U.S. Army and a former Department of Defense employee retiring in 2019.

He is married to the former Angenette Eddie. He is a father, grandfather, and husband.

Pastor Elder firmly stands on the words of Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."



History of Veterans Day

World War I – known at the time as "The Great War" – officially ended when the Treaty of Versailles was signed on June 28, 1919, in the Palace of Versailles outside the town of Versailles, France. However, fighting ceased seven months earlier when an armistice, or temporary cessation of hostilities, between the Allied nations and Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month. For that reason, November 11, 1918, is generally regarded as the end of "the war to end all wars."

Veterans Day is observed on November 11, regardless of what day of the week on which it falls. The observance of Veterans Day not only preserves the historical significance, but helps focus attention on the important purpose of Veterans Day: A celebration to honor America's veterans for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good.

In November 1919, President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day with the following words: "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations..."
