ACCOUNTABILITY

What: Accountability in the bible is being responsible for one's actions before God.



ACCOUNTABILITY

What: Accountability also means taking ownership of your assignments and showing initiative in getting things done.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Why: Accountability is important to ensure that each member of a team is doing what is expected and when it is expected.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Romans 14:12 In summary it describes a day when each individual will stand alone before God Almighty to "give account". No Excuses, No hidden agendas, No chance to lie and get away with it.

Ultimately we are all accountable to Christ, not others!

The Context of this Verse speaks to the diversity in the Christian Fellowship, encouraging believers to allow for differences of opinion in matters that do not conflict with God's word.

Paul says in Phil2.2 "Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling



Personal Growth Through Personal Accountability (Jeremiah 3:11)

- Partners In Accountability
 - Requires Self-Accountability
 - Pure Motives, and the absence of hypocritical judgment
 - Not holding someone else to standards we are not willing to meet ourselves
 - Accountability partners should be maturing Christians who have the desire and time to invest in relationships with others
- Types of Accountability Personal accountability is every Christian's Privilege and Responsibility (2 Cor. 5:10)
 - We can ask God in prayer to show us what needs to be addressed in our lives



Personal Growth Through Personal Accountability (Jeremiah 3:11)

- Categories of Accountability
 - Restorative Accountability
 - Preventative Accountability
 - Constructive Accountability
 - Task-oriented Accountability
- Enemies of Accountability
 - Includes denial and lies (2 Sam. 12:1-7) and (Col. 3.9)
 - Other obstacles include blame and pride

Humility is the cornerstone of accountability

No accountability relationship can tolerate continued sin on the part of one or both parties



Results of Accountability

- Church relationships that know one another fully and point each other to Christ by mutually loving one another as sufferers, sinners, and saints.
- When a group meet for accountability, questions are asked that encourage honesty and revelation. (Have you lied to anyone since we last met?)
- Accountability brings the body together in a supportive way to encourage us to grow in Christ
- It allows us to develop and use our gifts and promotes unity within the body.
- We grow by doing what is right
- Through Accountability, our faith is strengthened by the example of other's obedience
