Financial Items:

October Treasurer's Report

Amy Adome

- October pledge receipts are \$73,479, \$15,646 ahead of budget. YTD pledge receipts are \$542,693, (\$41,640) behind the YTD budget. Total YTD income through October is \$919,665 \$3,266 ahead of budget.
- The October expenses are \$108,825; \$10,554 above budget. YTD expenses of \$957,080, are (\$41,773) under budget. YTD the net income is (\$37,415), \$45,040 above budget. Janitorial Services were more than in the past and PTO was paid out.
- Preschool, Fund 2 The Preschool had a total operating income of \$9,578 in October, (\$1,006) below budget.
- Outreach, Fund 3 The balance in the General Outreach Fund is \$98,607. The Haiti Fund is low at \$7,964 and the next payment (December) of \$10,000

- is not covered but there is a lack of stability in the country so for now the next payment is on hold until conditions allows us to send.
- Building, Fund 5 As of 10/31/2022 the total pledges, contributions, and other income to Honor Faith Build Future are \$7,705,753.
- Concerning the Security Grant for \$100,000, \$96,000 has been spent but only \$88,000 has been approved but not yet paid. The remaining \$8,000, Elizabeth Carey will provide bookkeeper documents and Susan M-D and Jim Macemon will submit invoice to cover the variance.

The church banquet tables are broken and need replacement. Since they are plastic and are rolled in and out of storage as needed, their life span has expired. Facilities Manager, Mike Jewett has requested to purchase 12 new tables. Bill A. noted the costs will come out of Repairs and Replacement Fund.

Approve purchasing 12 round tables for a total of \$3,228 (\$269 each).

Amy shared that the Outreach Committee has requested an emergency contribution to the Episcopal Refugee Network of San Diego. Funds will be covered by the Outreach Fund 3.
