VOGM was established about 30 years ago by three gospel ministers in Embu area. These ministers initially worked with Church of God (Anderson movement). VOGM eventually broke away from that movement and began a partnership with CGGC about 16 years ago.

This past year, 2024, was very tough with the rain coming down very heavily and causing floods and overflowing to homes of some of our members. Global Reach helped to buy foodstuffs and blankets. We are thankful for your kind gifts.

We were also saddened that two of our churches left to work with prosperity gospel people. That leaves VOGM with 8 churches. We are very keen on evangelism and revivals although we face very hard ground against the face of prosperity gospel which has overtaken us here in most parts of Kenya.

We thank you for the continuous support without which the work would be very minimal in Kenya. The pastoral training is most important for us to spiritually mature and lead the church members away from the false doctrines of the prosperity gospel. The government of Kenya has made requirements for pastors to obtain

proper theological

credentials to maintain our callings as officially recognized pastors serving with VOGM as we maintain our churches. We see a bright future as you invest in our pastors training partnership with Winebrenner Theological Seminary.

We also greatly appreciate the scholarship support you provide for some college and high school students. Many needy children have attained education through these scholarship funds over the last 15 years. They are now adults in professional careers like teaching, engineers, and nurses.

Recently, VOGM has approached some micro-loan donors from other countries like RBN of Netherlands. We proposed a business plan to acquire donations to help people raise poultry in their homes. The first phase we will serve the Ithanga area among the most destitute squatters. There is a great potential for growth and expansion of ministry in Kenya including the Ithanga area.
