Dear Friends and Supporters,
Despite the ongoing turmoil in Haiti, we are witnessing the faithfulness of God in powerful ways. Our churches continue to thrive, and we are seeing more people coming to Christ and being baptized. Our evangelization efforts have intensified, and several of our churches recently celebrated their anniversaries, reminders that God's work is alive and growing even in difficult times.

Ministry Growth & Impact

Our schools are currently full of students, which is a great blessing. Beyond education, we are intentionally sharing the Gospel within the schools by introducing Bible classes as part of the curriculum. Our desire is that these students not only grow academically but also spiritually so they can carry the message of Christ back to their families.

As summer approaches, schools across Haiti are preparing to close the academic year, with national exams taking place before the break in June or early July.

Challenges We Are Facing

While we celebrate growth, we are also facing serious challenges:

- Our PT school is struggling financially due to lack of support
 - Many families are unable to pay tuition because of unemployment
 - The ongoing crisis has made it difficult to sustain teachers and staff
- As of May 2026, Haiti is experiencing a severe humanitarian crisis:
- Over 1 million people were displaced
 - 5.4 million people facing acute hunger
 - Widespread school closures due to insecurity

In the Artibonite region, where many of our churches and schools are located, gang violence continues to cause deaths, displacement, and fear. Public services have largely collapsed, limiting access to healthcare and clean water. We were also forced to temporarily close our hospital in Pierre Payen due to gang activity and blocked roads. This hospital serves a large population and
