Title: Witness to Who Jesus is

Scripture: John 1:19-28

What we learn from the witness, John the Baptist, and the five questions he was asked:

Question 1: Who are you? (vs. 19-20)

Lesson 1: Confess your true identity in Christ.

John makes the identity conversation a GOSPEL conversation.

Question 2: Are you Elijah? (v. 21)

Lesson 2: Choose your convictions and models wisely and carefully.

3 Influences of convictions and models

- Appearance (Matt. 3:4, 2 Kings 1:8)
- Actions (1 Kings 18:16-18, Matt. 3:1-2, Matt. 14:3-4)
- Admissions (Matt. 11:14; Luke 1:17)

Question 3: Are you THE prophet? (v. 21)

Lesson 3: Commit to learning and speaking the Word of God.

Question 4: What do you say about yourself? (vs. 22-24)

Lesson 4: Call people to Jesus, not yourself. (Isaiah 40:3-5)

• Call people to repent and believe on Jesus as Savior.

Question 5: What then do you baptize with if you are neither the Messiah, nor Elijah, nor the **Prophet?** (vs. 25-28)

Lesson 5: Commission Christ followers to call others to Christ.
