Title: You Must Be Born Again

Scripture: John 3:1-13

1. You must come to Jesus. (v. 1)

• Ruler or no power. Religious or Non-religious. Rich or poor.

Honest question: Have you come to Jesus?

2. You must be born again. (v. 7)

Hard truth: No one can see the Kingdom of God unless he is born again. (vs. 3, 5)

- **Two births:** Physical and Spiritual.
- Two parents: Physical Mother & Father. Spiritual The Spirit of God (v. 5) and the Word of God. (James 1:18; 1 Peter 1:23-25)
- The Spirit of God takes the Word of God and, when the sinner believes, imparts the life of God.

Honest question: Have you been born again?

- 3. You must believe in Jesus. (v. 12)
 - Belief is a necessity, but it is also a mystery.
 - Belief in Jesus continuously grows.

Honest question: What are you doing to grow your belief?
