Title: Seeking Worshippers Who Worship In Spirit and in Truth

Scripture: John 4:1-45

1. Worship begins with God engaging us. (vs. 1-8)

2. God reveals Himself through His gift of spirit and truth (the word). (vs. 9-14; John 7:37-39)

- 3. Worship in the spirit and truth (the word) leads to conviction of sin. (vs. 15-19)
- 4. Worship in spirit and truth clears up misconceptions about engaging with God. (vs. 20-23)
- 5. Worship in spirit and truth leads to going to tell truth. (vs. 24-30)
- Worship that goes in spirit and truth draws others to engage with God. (vs. 31-42)
- 7. Worship never ends because God never stops seeking those who will worship Him in spirit and truth. (vs. 43-45)
