Series: Jesus Is (17) Title: Mercy and Grace Scripture: John 5:1-18

Jesus gives abundant mercy and grace:

- Bethesda (House of Mercy) is really a house of misery. Jesus is the House of Mercy and he comes to the house of misery to deliver mercy.
- 1. Jesus knows your needs and misery. (vs. 1-7)
 - a. Physical needs
 - b. Spiritual needs
 - c. Emotional needs
 - d. Mental needs
 - e. Relational needs
- 2. Jesus gives compassion and mercy. (vs. 5-8)
 - a. His mercy is intentional
 - b. His mercy is unconditional
 - c. His mercy is complete
- 3. Jesus shows his power and might. (vs. 8-16)
 - a. Jesus heals with the power of His spoken word
 - b. Jesus is Lord of our lives
 - c. Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath
- 4. Jesus reveals his glory and grace. (vs. 17-18)
 - a. Jesus is equal with Father God.
 - b. Jesus is LIFE. (vs. 24-29)



So what?

- 1. What are you looking to get out of Jesus?
- 2. Do you want to be made well inside and out?
- 3. Right standing with God is more important than you being healed or getting the answer that you want! (v. 14)
- 4. Will you trust the Lord if He doesn't physically heal you before we see Jesus?
- 5. Will you give the same abundant mercy and grace to others that you have received?
