Essentials of Jesus

- 1. Authority (vs. 19-23)
 - a. Jesus is the authority to Work Redemption. (vs. 19-21)
 - b. Jesus is the authority to Judge Sin. (v. 22)
 - c. Jesus is the authority to be Honored. (v. 23)
- 2. Resurrection (vs. 24-29)
 - a. Jesus resurrects dead sinners from death to life (vs. 24-27)
 - i. Through His Word & Belief the Father sent Jesus. (v. 24)
 - ii. Jesus is the Son of Man & the Son of God. (vs. 25, 27)
 - iii. Jesus is LIFE. (v. 26, John 14:6)
 - b. Jesus will resurrect the dead in Christ (vs. 28-29a)
 - i. The dead in Christ will rise first. (1 Thess. 4:13-18)
 - ii. All believers will put on imperishable immortality. (1 Cor. 15:51-58)
 - c. Jesus will resurrect the dead rejecters of Christ (v. 29b)
 - i. Jesus will judge by what was written in the book and according to what they've done. (Rev. 20:11-15)
- 3. Witness (John 5:30-47)
 - a. Jesus bears witness about the Father's love.
 - b. The Father bears witness that Jesus is God.
 - c. John the Baptist & the prophets bear witness that Jesus saves.
 - d. Jesus miraculous works bear witness Jesus is God.
 - e. Moses and the Law bear witness that Jesus saves.



- 4. Scripture (vs. 39-40, 46-47)
 - a. The Scriptures point to Jesus.
 - b. The Scriptures are fulfilled in Jesus.
- 5. Glory (vs. 41-45)
 - a. Jesus does not need glory from people.
 - b. Glory comes from God.
 - c. God's glory is displayed:
 - i. through His love.
 - ii. through His law.
 - iii. through His sending Jesus.
