Title: Determined Amidst Disbelief

Scripture: John 7:1-24

We must not allow deserters or disbelievers to deter us from making disciples.

- The success of a church is not the size of the congregation, but the depth of the discipleship.
- 1. Jesus did not allow His disbelieving family deter Him from His Father's work of making disciples. (Matt. 28:18-20) (vs. 1-10)
- 2. We must not allow disbelieving family members deter us from making disciples.
 - 1) Jesus valued humble serving. His disbelieving family valued being seen and recognized. (v. 3)
 - 2) Jesus was willing to lose uncommitted followers. His family wanted Jesus to do miracles to get followers. (vs. 3-4)
 - 3) Jesus was patient for His Father's timing. His family did what they wanted when they wanted. (v. 6)
 - Jesus' brothers (siblings) show us that we can be in close proximity to Jesus and still miss who Jesus is and what He is doing.
- 3. Jesus contended with disbelieving leaders and fickle people with consistent character, sound doctrine, and selfless works.
- 4. We contend with disbelieving leaders and fickle people with consistent character, sound doctrine, and selfless works.

So what?

1. Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment. (1 John 4:1, Romans 12:1-2)
