- 6. I am the Resurrection and the LIFE. John 11:25-26
- 7. Jesus is the True Vine. The True Vine is the Real Savior. John 15:1, 5

The Real Savior has real people as disciples. (John 15:5)

 - Help us remember the words of Jesus (16:4a)
