

## 2023 Worship Volunteer Opportunities

Listed below are descriptions of current Worship Volunteer Opportunities.

**USHERING**– while we don't have Ushers every Sunday, we do need them on holidays and special Sundays. Duties would include distributing the bulletins, greeting at the door and passing the offering plate.

- **Holidays:** Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter, Christmas Eve services
- **Sundays would be the 8:30, 9:45 and 11:15 services** on Communion Sundays, Scout Sunday, Mother's Day, Father's Day, etc.

**DECORATING (set-up/clean-up) the Chapel and Sanctuary:** There are several times during the year when we decorate or must set-up/clean-up the Chapel and Sanctuary for special events and need help doing so. Decorating or setting up could require your help during the week.

- **Communion Sundays** – help set up the Communion supplies for each worship service
- **Fellowship Sundays** - On Fellowship Sundays, we often decorate both the Sanctuary Lobby and Sanctuary Courtyard. (Pentecost Sunday, Mother's Day, Father's Day).
- **Easter Lilies** – setting out the Easter Lilies after the Good Friday service so they are in place before Easter Sunday.
- **Christmas Poinsettias**– setting out poinsettias the week of Thanksgiving so they are in place by the first Sunday in Advent.
- **Christmas Eve candles** – preparing candles for the Christmas Eve services. This is usually done anytime during the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of December. We try to schedule it at times that are convenient for those volunteering.
- **Pew Stuffing** – adding information to the pew racks that is needed for worship services (sharpened pencils, visitor cards, offering envelopes, etc.)

**Cleaning up** would require your help after the service. This could be as simple as clearing the pews of leftover bulletins before the next service.
