Requirements

- A personal commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior
- Excitement for working with children of all ages and needs (preschool-elementary).
- · Experience working with kids
- A collaborative spirit and the ability to work well with a team.
- Confidence leading groups of children and helping create fun, meaningful experiences.
- Strong organization, initiative, and creativity.
- High school graduates or high school applicants who will have completed 11th grade.

- Summer Celebration (VBS) July 13-17

General Responsibilities

- Help plan and lead Summer Sunday School and Summer Celebration (VBS).
- Assist with Mission Extreme, preschool events, and other summer programs.
- Bring energy, creativity, and leadership to activities, worship, games, and small groups.

Working Relationships

• Interns work closely with and are supervised by the Children's Ministry Staff, following guidelines from MDPC Session and the Personnel Committee.

Salary & Duration

- \$16/hour, part-time. Interns who work all scheduled hours typically earn about \$4,000 over the summer.
- Internship runs May 26–August 2, 2026. Most weeks are Sunday–Wednesday (schedule varies with programming).
- Time off is discouraged and must be approved by the Children's Ministries Director prior to May 1. No time off is permitted during major events.
