Amazing Place provides free Brain Health classes to educate on dementia, memory preservation, and aging process navigation, as 45% of dementia cases can be prevented through lifestyle changes.





Each year, graduates are sent into remote parts of Mexico where they lead churches and teach the sacrificial love of Christ through the way they live.
