## Missionary Partner:

### Couple Serving in Tbilisi

This MDPC missionary couple supports communities of Arab, Persian and Turkish Christians from a Muslim background. Through their Christian center in Tbilisi, Georgia, they disciple and equip maturing believers to be a light in their community of origin and shepherd Christ-centered, biblically based, multiplying churches.

## Missionary Partner:

### Dr. Miguel and Laura

MDPC Field Partner Dr. Miguel and his family show God's compassion to the unreached by meeting physical needs through dental health. Dr. Miguel practices and teaches dentistry while sharing the Good News of Jesus with tribes living in abject poverty in Southeast Asia. There, the 98% Muslim population has the least amount of dental care in the world.

## Missionary Partner:

### Family Serving In Saudi Arabia

This MDPC partner family lives in Saudi Arabia where they seek to introduce college age students to Jesus and build intentional relationships. Through teaching at a university and leading workshops and webinars, they have the opportunity to meet college students as well as their friends and families. Pray that the students they disciple will be a light in their country and will influence their society as they become leaders.

## Missionary Partner:

### Family Serving in SE Asia

A and S serve in SE Asia, advancing the gospel in a region experiencing political instability and conflict. Their work includes equipping leaders through seminary teaching, developing children's ministry curriculum, and providing discipleship and relief support to local communities. They also partner with area churches to strengthen outreach efforts among least-reached groups, including youth and women's ministries. Pray for A, S, and their three children as they faithfully share the hope of Christ in a difficult context.

## Missionary Partner: Hannah and Mario

Hannah and Mario live in Lebanon where they lead a thriving media ministry and train disciple-makers in their community. They create Gospel centered social media content in Arabic to connect with unreached people in Lebanon and throughout the Arab world that are interested in learning about Christ. Hannah also provides trauma counseling and leads trauma healing Bible studies to minister to women in their region. Pray for Hannah, Mario and their outreach team as they proclaim Christ, engage seekers, and disciple new believers.

## Missionary Partner: Kim Zovak

MDPC Field Partner Rev. Kim Zovak equips high-level Kingdom leaders to multiply movements of the gospel and mobilizes the church for mission in less reached and less resourced parts of the world, particularly in Asia. Through her strategic mentoring, training, and coaching, she helps missionaries and national leaders develop their personal and professional capacities to serve God, and to intentionally multiply themselves by developing more leaders to do the same.

## Missionary Partner: Kristin Jones

MDPC Field Partner Kristin Jones is building relationships for the Kingdom and sharing the Gospel within the Bangladeshi community in New York City. After ten years living overseas in the Bengal region, she is fluent in Bengali and understands the culture. This allows her the opportunity to significantly impact Bangladeshi's lives as they adjust to America and to share the Good News of Jesus Christ.

## Missionary Partner:

### Rev. Mehrdad and Family

Rev. Mehrdad, the first Iranian ordained pastor in ECO, lives in Germany and serves as director of the Persian Ministry at Quest Academy. He equips and mentors Persian-speaking believers in Europe and the Middle East through theological training, discipleship, and leadership development. In partnership with churches and mission organizations, he supports house churches and encourages believers to grow in faith and ministry. Pray for Mehrdad, his wife, and their two sons as they raise up a new generation of faithful leaders.

MDPC Field Partner Urgessa works and serves in Ethiopia as the founder of Light of Hope Ministry Ethiopia (LOHME). The vision of LOHME is to bring the Good News of God's love to the Arsi Oromo people, both in Ethiopia and in North America. LOHME carries out their mission through building village schools, mobilizing local evangelists and missionaries, church planting, Bible translation into local dialects, and the vision of establishing a Christian Academy and training center.

## Berea Bible Institute

This small Bible college began as one family's dream to educate young leaders in Scripture and prepare future ministers to serve God in areas of great need in Mexico. Students are ingrained with a love for serving and for teaching their communities to reach out in service to their neighbors. Each year, graduates are sent into remote parts of Mexico where they lead churches and teach the sacrificial love of Christ through the way they live.

## Confidential Ministry in Egypt

This ministry partner mobilizes Egyptian missionaries and churches to share the Gospel with unreached people in Egypt and throughout the Arabic-speaking world. They serve in 15 countries across the Middle East and North Africa through outreach, discipleship, church planting, and leadership development. For security reasons, the organization's name cannot be published.

## Evangelical Theological Seminary in Cairo

Volunteer doctors, nurses, and dentists demonstrate God's love and compassion as they serve alongside local volunteers to provide healthcare to more than 24,000 Guatemalans annually.
