We Need Your Help Choosing New MDPC Officers

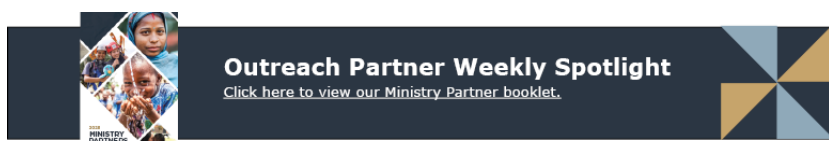
