While some involve weekly commitments, others are monthly or occasional to fit your schedule. We especially want to raise up the opportunity to join our adult mission trip this summer. We will be spending one week with our friends at the Tree of Life Mission on the Rosebud Reservation in South Dakota. Save the dates, June 4 through June 10, and connect with us through the QR code below.

USO – Assist traveling service persons, their families, and veterans with information, meals, and a friendly greeting either inside or outside of security at O'Hare Airport.

Meals with Wheels – Once a week, deliver catered lunchtime meals and provide a brief wellness check or older adults living on their own in Barrington.

Care Ministries – Visit with shut-ins, send cards, deliver meals, offer rides, and help care for our members and friends.

Vacation Bible School – Work with young children, teaching them about God and God's people. June 19 to June 23 in the morning or help with set up and decorations ahead of time.

Mission Committee – The Mission Committee works to present a variety of hands-on serving opportunities for BUMC members and to build respectful relationships with those we serve.

Congregational Garden – Work outdoors planting, weeding, and harvesting fresh vegetables for distribution to nine local food pantries.

Northern Illinois Food Bank – Work with our team sorting and preparing food to be distributed to food pantries, soup kitchens, or pop-up distribution centers. Non-physical jobs are available.

FISH Food Pantry – Donate hygiene items or groceries in the blue bins in the lobby or help at FISH on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday morning.

Carpentersville Community Meals – Host our guests for a meal at Trinity Center on the third Saturday of the month or help cook on Friday morning.

PADS (Public Action to Deliver Shelter) – Sign up to provide a meal once a month for guests or donate requested items.

Mentoring at Lakewood Elementary School – Have lunch once a week with your student or be a prayer partner for one of our mentor-student partnerships.
