ORDINARY TIME

THE SEASON OF ORDINARY TIME is composed of the weeks beginning after Pentecost and ending when Advent begins. The name of the season comes from the word "ordinal," meaning "showing order or denoting an order of succession." Ordinary Time is not a break from the Liturgical Year but is a time with deep meaning, a time to experience the mystery of Christ in our everyday lives. The liturgical color for Ordinary Time is green, a sign of growth and hope.
