- Written to a Jewish audience

II. THE FAMILY PLAN (v. 18a)

- 1st Century Jewish
 MARRIAGES
- A <u>BETROTHAL</u>
- Everybody wins, right?

III. MARY'S REALITY AND JOSEPH'S PLAN

(vv. 18b-19; Luke 1:26-38; Isaiah 7:14)

- Mary's **FUTURE** is set, until it isn't
- Joseph makes a plan:
 - **CERTIFICATE** of divorce (Deuteronomy 24:1-4)
 - Handled _____QUIETLY _____
 - To spare her life
- Joseph was a ______ man
