SUMMARY:

Fosters an environment where students and teachers are encouraged to experiment, explore, create, and collaborate in a technology-rich academic environment. Provides academic instruction to the students of St. John's Lutheran School in accordance with requirements set forth by the State of California. Prepares and develops lesson plans and other instructional materials for assigned classes. Coaches and encourages teachers in advanced technology instruction techniques. Exemplifies the Christian philosophy of the St. John's Lutheran Church mission statement in all aspects of day-to-day duties and responsibilities.

POSITION ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Demonstrates values and attributes in connection with the faith being taught by St. John's. Lutheran Church, with the purpose of being a role model to employees and those being served.
- Troubleshoots and assists teachers and students with a variety of technology issues and problems.
- Creates, organizes, teaches, co-teaches, and coaches plans and grades a variety of curriculum units and classes with K – 8th grade teachers.
- Organizes and manages all STEM Lab equipment, including iPads, furniture, 3D printers and spaces.
- Investigates and helps administration with student technology discipline issues.
- Manages distribution of and collecting of iPads including the signing of the family and iPad contracts at the beginning and end of year.
- Trains teachers in the use of a variety of technology equipment.
- Directs the LMS (Google Classroom) for students and teachers.
- Trains teachers on all appropriate school technologies.
- In collaboration with IT team, manages, uploads, and maintains all online curriculum and educational accounts for students and teachers (Clever Accounts).
- Manages Apple Distinguished School from application to fulfillment and beyond.
- Collaborates with the Curriculum Leadership Team (CLT) on all aspects of student learning.
