World Conference Resolution 1326 is a bold statement urging us to confront the sin of racism and create a just, peaceful, and equitable society for all.

We acknowledge the part we play in perpetuating racist systems. We call for a renewed commitment to confront and eliminate all circumstances of racist experience and affirm "the aim of Community of Christ is nothing less than an inclusive church in an inclusive society." (WCR 1326).

As followers of Jesus Christ, who taught us how to love, we are called to use our voice and actions to challenge systems of racial injustice found throughout the world. We dedicate ourselves to listen deeply to members and friends who experience racism, to educate ourselves on the sin of racism, to speak up, and to take action toward full equality. We recognize that racial injustice is intertwined with other systems of power. We renew our commitment to support through deed and action all who experience pain, violence, and separation from community because of unjust and racist systems.
