

Step 8: Claim It

Speak and believe all things are possible!

Claiming God's will over our lives is not only an option, but also a God-given responsibility. As believers in Jesus, we have the ability to frame our environment, our situations, and our day-to-day lives through the prism of God's Word. God's Word is not a gimmick... it's not a hustle... and He is not a genie in a bottle. What He is.... He is a way-maker! He is a miracle worker! He is a promise keeper! He is the light in the darkness! We are able to claim His will in our lives. How do we do that? By pronouncing/declaring His Word

Question: What are you believing God for in this season?

I. Step 8: Claim It

2 Corinthians 4:13 AMP states, ***'Yet we have the same spirit of faith as he had, who wrote in Scripture, "I believed, therefore I spoke."*** We also believe, therefore we also speak, [Ps 116:10]'

a. What is my position of authority?

- In Him!!!

1. Ephesians 1:7 AMP
2. ***'In Him we have redemption [that is, our deliverance and salvation] through His blood, [which paid the penalty for our sin and resulted in] the forgiveness and complete pardon of our sin, in accordance with the riches of His grace'***
3. 1 John 3:5-6
4. ***'You know that He appeared [in visible form as a man] in order to take away sins; and in Him there is [absolutely] no sin [for He has neither the sin nature nor has He committed sin or acts worthy of blame]. No one who abides in Him [who remains united in fellowship with Him—deliberately, knowingly, and habitually] practices sin. No one who habitually sins has seen Him or known Him.'***

Step 8: Claim It

- Recognition of the Source!
 1. Matthew 28:18 AMP
 2. ***'Jesus came up and said to them, "All authority (all power of absolute rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to Me.'***

- b. What does expectation look like?
 - Psalms 5:3 AMP
 - ***'In the morning, O Lord , You will hear my voice; In the morning I will prepare [a prayer and a sacrifice] for You and watch and wait [for You to speak to my heart]. '***

 - Micah 7:7 AMP
 - ***'But as for me, I will look expectantly for the Lord and with confidence in Him I will keep watch; I will wait [with confident expectation] for the God of my salvation. My God will hear me. '***

 - Psalms 62:5 AMP and TPT
 - ***'For God alone my soul waits in silence and quietly submits to Him, For my hope is from Him. '***

 - ***'I am standing in absolute stillness, silent before the one I love, waiting as long as it takes for him to rescue me. Only God is my Savior, and he will not fail me.'***

***Question to Ponder: Have you been living in denial instead of claiming the possibilities that are possible to come to your life? Do you need to change your language to speak faith into every situation in your life?**

Transformational Practices: Meditate on Job 22:28 for the next 3 days. Now, make a list of your new declaration of faith, then decree them by faith daily. ("You will also decide and decree a thing, and it will be established for you; And the light [of God's favor] will shine upon your ways."
