

Prince of Peace Confirmation Class 2024-2025

- <u>Curriculum</u>: Our Confirmation Program is a 2-year journey with one year of Bible Overview and one year of Luther's Small Catechism. This year, our first year and second year students will be in the same class, and we will be going through our **one year of Bible Overview.** Students will be provided with a bible, notebook, and small catechism, which all need to be **brought to class each week**.
- <u>Timeliness</u>: Confirmation Class is on <u>Sundays from 9:15am to 10:15am</u>. Class will always start on time and end on time. Students are expected to be respectful of our class time together by <u>arriving to class on time and staying the full hour</u>. Parents are strongly encouraged to stick around during Sunday School Hour and attend one of our Adult Classes.
- <u>Fellowship and Service:</u> The journey of faith is more than just a cognitive venture. To have a well-rounded Confirmation experience, students are encouraged to attend weekly worship, get involved in Youth Events, and will be challenged to get involved in service opportunities. Following our vision: Know God, Grow Together, Serve the World!
- Make-Up Work: Students who miss part or all of a class (including students who
 are tardy) will be given make-up work on the material they missed. This is to
 ensure that they don't miss any learning and can keep up with the rest of the
 class. The make-up assignment will be emailed to the parents and students and
 should be handed in at the next class session.
- <u>Family Follow-Up:</u> Each week, a lesson summary will be sent out to Confirmation families describing what we learned in class that week. Parents, help solidify the lesson by going over major points with your student at home!
- Youth Retreat: We are planning to attend the Southeastern District High School Youth Gathering on November 1st-3rd, and the Southeastern District Middle School Youth Gathering on March 21st-23rd. These retreats will be packed with worship, Bible Study and fun! Confirmation students are strongly encouraged to attend the retreat for their grade level.
