be patient in tribulation,

be constant in prayer.

(13) Contribute to the needs of the saints

and seek to show hospitality.

Practical Application

- 1. God's merciful love for us in Jesus Christ should change the way we live practically each day.
- 2. In light of God's great love, we should love God and people genuinely & sincerely from the depths of our heart.
- 3. You can rest in the fact that Jesus died for your imperfect love. Now you can grow in love each day through the Holy Spirit.
- 4. God wants you to hate evil and love good. Do you hate what God hates and love what God loves?
- 5. Love your brothers and sisters in Christ with a special family affection. Ask God to mature your emotions and feelings. We all need God's help with this.
- 6. A form of healthy competition is trying to honor others more than they honor you. Honor others each day.
- 7. We are freed to honor others because in Jesus Christ we have been made honored sons and daughters of God. Our secure position of honor enables us to honor others.
- 8. Jesus was shamed so that you might be honored. Understanding the gospel changes the way we live in very practical, down to earth, and daily ways.
- 9. Christians should be the most zealous, passionate, hard working, disciplined, and fervant people in the world. Don't give in to laziness, sloth, and lukewarmness.
- 10. Serve God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength.
- 11. Because of Christ there is always hope. You can have a joy each day that the world can't.
- 12. You can patiently endure when you go through hard times because you know they will not last forever for you. God is working in your waiting.
- 13. God wants you to have an ongoing relationship with Him each day that is characterized by talking and listing to Him. Learn to pray without ceasing.
- 14. Give to Christians in a special way when they have genuine needs. Be as generous as you possibly can be.
- 15. Be a warm, inviting, caring, and a lovingly hospitable person.
