Pastor: There are a few stories in the Bible that are troubling. These stories are challenging and make us think. God is revealed to be a little different from what we have come to expect. Today's story is one of these, the story of God coming to Jacob, the great patriarch, and wrestling with him through a long, dark night. I wonder if we can be so comfortable with God that the idea that God confronts us, changes us and, yes, even attacks us is, yes . . . troubling, to say the least. You see, we do not make God, God makes us. This is the theme for our worship this morning.
