

1848 to 2023 - Stilled Called to Serve!

Devotionals - 23 - 29 April 2023 ~ Read: Matthew 20

Today's chapter is Matthew 20. In this chapter Jesus will go further into telling His disciples what He came to accomplish. As they continue to think Jesus has come to fill their expectations, Jesus continues to try to get them to pay attention to what He's trying to teach them. He's telling them He's going to die and in verse 21 they'll ask if they can sit on His right and His left, asking for the positions of power in

His kingdom. In light of their incorrect view of what it means to be great, Jesus has to set the record straight. And this isn't just one person's opinion. This is Jesus Christ's view on greatness which means specifically that this is God's view of what it means to be great. What He says is simply astounding.

After hearing Jesus words (Matthew 20:25-28), their jaws hit the ground! Completely contrary to everything they'd seen and heard their whole lives - especially from the religious leaders. So, then what is true greatness?

Notice the last part of Jesus' words: "...just as the Son of Man (Jesus) did not come to be served, but to serve..." Jesus is saying to us, "Look at what I'm doing here! Not only am I giving you the perfect example to follow but I'm also proving this isn't some intellectual exercise by the simple fact that I'm doing what I'm telling you to do!"

If Jesus claimed to be God - and He is - and His records bears that fact out - check it out for yourself; it does! Then there's no one else who could ever know the level of humility Jesus knew when He left heaven and came to earth to serve His creation. Imagine, the God of all creation, the One who has legitimate right to demand all service be rendered to Him, and He comes and serves us instead! This doesn't make any sense...

Jesus Christ comes and says, "Instead of you serving Me, I came and served you. Instead of you serving me to earn your way into heaven, because I earned heaven for you and give it to you freely by faith, now your service comes from gratitude instead of obligation." This is what Jesus came to do and here we see that greatness isn't in how much power you accumulate, how much money you have, or how many people call you "boss".

True greatness is found as we serve those around us without regard for our own gain or loss. When we see others as more important than ourselves - as Jesus clearly did - and we find our worth in God's estimation of us instead of humanities, then we're free to serve everyone as Christ served us; we remember Jesus' words that with God all things are possible (Matthew 19:26).
