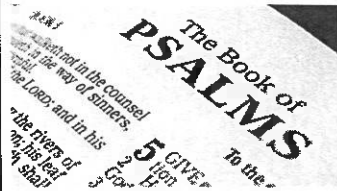

A Thank You Note

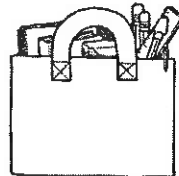
Recently several people have thanked me for the new outdoor Nativity Scene. This was a group effort!
