While at camp, students will have the option to be a part of one of three major tracks (choir, orchestra, or praise band). Simultaneously, students will participate in three electives that also meet daily. Examples of electives include acoustic guitar, electric guitar, drums, boys' vocal, girls' vocal, audio/video technology, etc. At the end of the week, all campers will participate in putting on a 90-minute worship service.
