
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

WELCOME TO PASTOR DEVIN O DCE INTERN MARGO!*





TRI-AREA MINISTRY







CHANGES COMING SOON

NEW PROGRAMMING FOR HOPE KIDS & YOUTH

This summer we are making programming changes to enhance the Christian education experience for Hope's kids and youth. For many years, the Kids Ministry program was for birth-grade 4, and the Youth Ministry program covered grades 5-12, with Confirmation classes normally held in grades 5-6. Starting this summer, we will be shifting the transition point between Kids and Youth Ministry, and the years for Confirmation. All Hope members and friends are asked to pray for the Kids Ministry, Youth Ministry, and Confirmation Ministry programs, and for the impact these programs make on the kids and youth of our church and community.



KIDS MINISTRY

This program is now for birth-grade 5. A brand-new program for grades 4-5, Club 45, will feature age-appropriate Sunday School lessons focusing on a comprehensive two-year Bible overview, First Holy Communion classes and celebration (scheduled for grade 5 students/families in February), family activities and retreat, and more. A meeting on June 4 (12:15PM) for rising grades 4-5 students and parents/guardians will provide more exciting information about Club 45.


YOUTH
