Pefugee Aid Motes Ukrainian Support Initiative (USI)

We are excited to announce that Hope was recently awarded a grant for support of Ukrainian refugees in our community! The grant was given by our national church body, the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod. A team has been formed to review aid requests (examples are daycare assistance, rent assistance, cell phone or utility assistance).

Hope has been involved in refugee support for over a year and a half, helping recent arrivals from several areas of the world. To date, efforts have centered around areas such as:

- food security
- clothing donations
- home goods donations
- furniture moving
- daycare scholarships
- rent support
- transportation assistance
- cultural orientation/appointment support


