#### THE PASTORAL GREETING


The sign of the cross may be made by all in remembrance of their Baptism.

Steve Mortensen, age 73, of Wake Forest, NC passed away on Sunday December 8, 2024 at his home surrounded by loved ones.

Steve was born on March 7, 1951 to Martin and Estella (Nordmeyer) Mortensen. He grew up in Rising City, NE as the youngest of three boys and graduated from Rising City High School in 1969.
