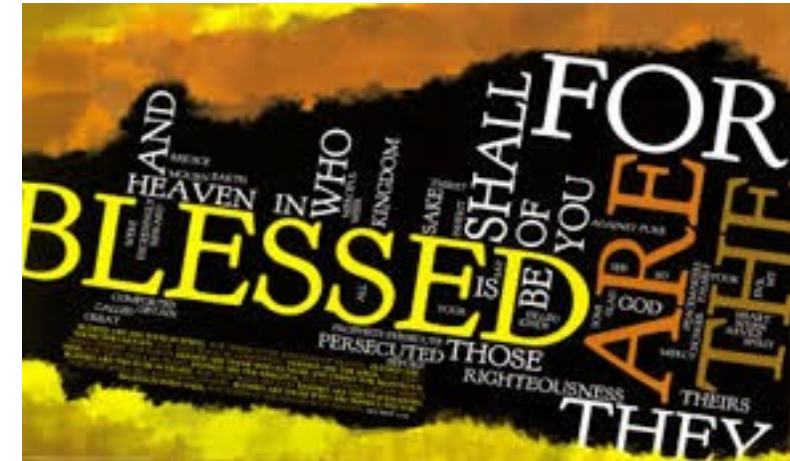

Barnabas Group - February

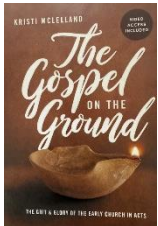

Scam Reminder to be Vigilant

We've seen an increase in scam attempts targeting our community and parishioners, using the name of our pastor and staff to solicit funds or personal information. Please be extremely cautious of any unsolicited messages (emails, texts, calls) that:

- Urge immediate action or create a sense of crisis.
- Ask for money, gift cards, wire transfers, or sensitive data like credit card or bank info
- Come from unofficial email addresses or unknown numbers

What to do:

- Do NOT reply, click links, open attachments, or send money or gift cards
- Verify by calling the church office at (717) 258-6704
- Delete suspicious messages and report them to the FTC if you wish (reportfraud.ftc.gov)
