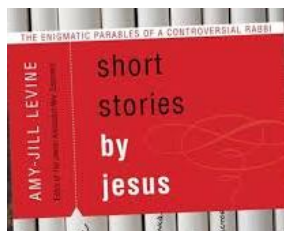
What's Happening at Otterbein!
