What is the Filling of the Holy Spirit?

***•The Holy Spirit empowering believers
for the purpose of making His presence
known through the wisdom we pursue,
the gratitude we express, and the unity
we reflect.(Eph. 5:15-18)***

**The Indwelling, Filling, and
Baptism of the Spirit**

- The **Indwelling** of the Spirit is His *Personal Presence* in the Believer; The **Filling of the Spirit** is His *Perpetual Power* through the Believer; **The Baptism of the Spirit** is His *Permanent Partnership* with the Believer.

- ¹⁸ And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, **but be filled with the Spirit**

**Be Filled with the Spirit
(Eph. 5:18)**

1. **Be Filled (Imperative Verb)** The filling of the Spirit is a command to all believers
2. **Be Filled (Passive Verb)** The filling of the Spirit is a work that God must do in the believer.

**Be Filled with the Spirit
(Eph. 5:18)**

3. **Be Filled (Present Tense Verb)** The filling of the Holy Spirit is a continuous work in believers.
4. **Be Filled (Plural Verb)** The filling of the Holy Spirit is accessible to all believers.

**The Filling of the Spirit Affects
Our Perception (5:15-17)**

- ¹⁵ Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

**The Filling of the Spirit Affects our
Praise (5:19-20)**

- ¹⁸ And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹ addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart,

**The Filling of the Spirit Affects our
Praise (5:19-20)**

- ²⁰ giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

**The Filling of the Spirit Affects our
Partnership (5:21)**

- ²¹ submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Follow the 'Filling' in Ephesians

- ²² And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, ²³ which is his body, **the fullness of him who fills all in all. (Eph. 1:22-23)**
- ¹⁹ and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, **that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. (Eph. 3:19)**

Follow the 'Filling' in Ephesians

- ¹³ until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the **stature of the fullness of Christ**,
- *** ²² In him you also are **being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.** (Eph. 2:22)
