## Live It Out

### 1. Start Your Day with a Promise

Before the demands of the day hit, anchor yourself in the truth. Read Romans 8:31 or 8:38–39 and speak it aloud. Let it reset your heart. Why not put a verse on a sticky note and post it some where you'll see it throughout the day.

### 2. Refuse the Lies of Insecurity

When fear, failure, or doubt whisper that you're not enough—respond with truth. God's love isn't based on your performance, and nothing can separate you from Him.

### 3. Live Like You're Loved

God's love gives you freedom to live with courage. Step into your day focusing on the truth that you're fully embraced by Jesus—and let that truth, and the confidence it brings, spill over into how you love others.
